From India:

From Bangladesh:

First we like to thank you for your ministry for sending Love Package to our ministry for last few years. We are so grateful for your faithful on going support through Love Package. It is a great help you are doing to reach the children of Bangladesh. We are using all of your Love Package's pictures, materials and books in our children's and teenager's programs. We are also giving those wonderful materials to the children workers of various denominations in Bangladesh. Each of them is using all those materials in their own churches and Sunday schools.

From the Philippines:

The Love Packages will be distributed to around 2,000 church partners nationwide and since June, we have already distributed sets of 15 manuals to 200 churches in Metro Manila and it is still on-going. We target to finish distributions in August. The materials will be used by pastors and church workers as reference/

teaching materials in Bible studies, preaching, small groups and Sunday schools and other outreach activities.

From Tanzania:

We gave 10 full Boxes of Literature (Books and tracts) to a born again Policeman for free distribution. He is a long time distributor. After a long time, he sent a letter to our office testifying that he had distributed all materials and said that there is a hunger and thirst in the Police Community. Through his distribution he says many have heard the word of God, and are changed, touched and they need something more because it is not easy to be Policemen. He has been even contributing to help us take out Containers from the Port. I also received a letter from a Zambian prisoner asking for Gospel Literature. I don't know how he came to know our address. This Prisoner is asking Gospel materials for reading and giving to others. He is explaining the need of Gospel materials in their Prison there in Zambia. I thank God that there is a Container coming soon for Zambia and Malawi, we pray that God will open doors for Love Packages to continue helping Africa with the Gospel Materials.

From the Philippines


We now have more than 60,000 malnourished children on our feeding program throughout the Philippines. Feeding Centers are located in elementary schools and Day-Care Centers in 9 provinces, as well as in one or two municipalities in 16 other provinces. We are receiving excellent cooperation and are welcomed by the school officials as well as many local governments - the governors, mayors, etc. This reception and cooperation has not been extended to any other religious organization including the Roman Catholic Church. We are busy preparing to plant one church, or Bible study in each of the more than 1,300 towns that have feeding centers. In many remote towns and villages in the Provinces of Apayao, Kalinga and Ifugao, there has been absolutely no witness for the Lord Jesus Christ. Regardless of the claims of many radio and television evangelists, they have not reached these areas because there are no radio and televisions in many of these places. When we launched the feeding program in Apayao Province last Novem-

Greetings to you in the wonderful name of Jesus. This year begins our 35th year of collecting and sending Christian literature to the nations. Since our beginning, our one focus has been to glorify the Lord who has redeemed us by His own blood. The Lord has helped us and has been very gracious to us all these years. We have been able to ship 10,000 tons of literature around the world. That is five hundred million pieces of literature. Each book, tract, Bible, Sunday school quarterly is packed with Spiritual potential to change a life for eternity. Will you stop for a moment and think about that impact. Five hundred million pieces, and most of it is still on the field and is still being read. Will you stop and pray today for the people all over the world who are reading this literature. Your prayers matter.

Can I also ask you to pray about something else. In 35 years we have had times when we had no money, other times we were low on literature, or volunteers, but I have never seen what is going on right now. At the moment we are having a very hard time finding available containers for shipment overseas. Also many of our distributors are forced because of the economies in their countries to scale back on their container requests because they do not have the monies to clear the containers at the present time. Can you make these a matter of prayer? Thanks for praying.

Jason, who is an intern here, has been in India for the past 5 weeks. He has been meeting several of our distributors and hundreds and hundreds of people who have given their lives to Christ because of our literature. I want to remind all of you that what you are doing by collecting and sending these materials is important. Only eternity will reveal what God has done though your literature, prayers, and giving.

In closing, I just want to express my gratitude to all of you that help us. We can not get this work done without you. I remain, Yours for souls.

From Kenya:

I gave Bibles to some of our pastors who never have had one and have shared the remaining amongst the kids in the orphanage. I can't thank you enough for reaching the unfortunate with the word of God through your distribution. Many kids are learning the books of the Bible and the word therein, when they read it for themselves it makes more impact in their own lives and I have heard them refer their friends to a scripture in the Bible. They are also memorizing the word and reciting it to each other. Thank you.

Materials we can use.

- **Bibles (new or used):** All Bibles, New Testaments, Bible portions.
- **Tracts:** All tracts
- **Reference Books & Commentaries:** dictionaries, bible dictionaries, concordances, commentaries, etc.
- **Books & Paperbacks:** All Christian books - adult or children.
- **Magazines:** Magazines that contain a lot of advertising are not usable. Types of magazines that are acceptable are Discipleship Journal, Decision, Voice, Aglow, Christ for the Nations, Pentecostal Evangel, Leadership, Bread for the Children, etc.
- **Sunday School Supplies:** We accept adult quarterlies and all teacher manuals in any amount from all publishers. We accept children's quarterlies if you have the teacher's manual and at least 8 student manuals. Please DO NOT SEND any handiwork, craft, or busy work papers.
- **Daily Devotionals:** Upper Room, Daily Bread, In Touch, etc.
- **Tapes (cassette & VCR), CD's, DVD's,** music, movies, teaching. **Puppets, Bible games, Nativity sets, biblical puzzles:** anything that helps present the gospel to children
